RLD- Long-term residence or EU long-term residence recovery visa

To obtain a long-term resident or EU long-term resident recovery visa it is first necessary to submit an application to recover the permit. For this reason, the procedure has two stages. For the <u>first stage</u>, the applicant must contact the Spanish Embassy

		*National visa application form: Each applicant must complete and sign a visa application, filling in each of its sections. If the applicant is a minor, both of their parents or a duly accredited representative must sign the application.		
		*Valid, unexpired passport. Original and a photocopy of the page or pages of the passport that contain biometric data. The passport must have a minimum validity period of 4 months and contain two blank pages. Passports issued more than 10 years ago will not be accepted. *Photograph: A recent, 3.5*4.5, (for the last 3 month) color photograph,, taken against a light background, facing forward, without dark or reflective glasses, or any garments concealing the oval of the face.		
		*Legalized and translated Shenasnameh (Spanish translation for the last 6 month): For all the family members. If anyone has been born in Spain, he/she should provide it.		
		*Residence permit: Original and a copy of the favorable decision recognizing recovery of the long-term residence permit or EU long-term residence permit		
		*Proof of residence in the consular district (only for non Iranian nationals).
